The West Hants community has an amazing opportunity to help create a progressive, dynamic and healthy environment for our children

With great excitement, plans are now underway for a brand new, purpose built facility to house the Windsor Day Care. We are scheduled to break ground in the spring of 2010 and are actively asking for support from the community to help us reach our fund raising goals.

The goal of the Windsor Day Care Society capital campaign is to raise **\$325,000**. The campaign will enable the Windsor Day Care to better achieve its goals by alleviating the burden of a monthly mortgage payment, which will be difficult to sustain due to the decrease in public funding. This is the first time in its 34 year history that the Society has looked to the community to help fund a formal campaign.

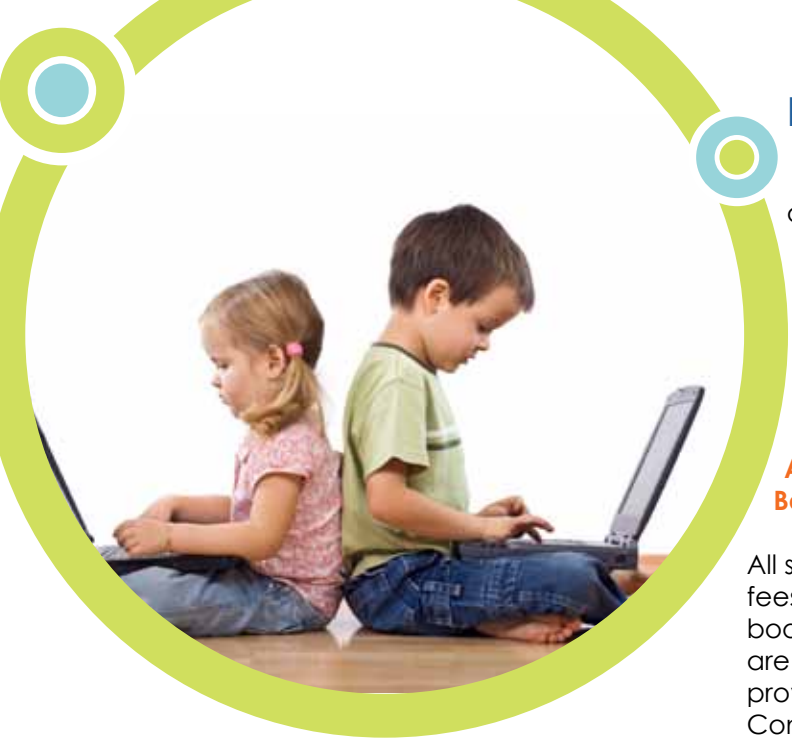

Programs

The Centre offers daily programs in each of the units, similar in format, addressing the needs of each particular child. The programs are generally theme related and change weekly.

- Playgroup** - ages 18mo - 3yrs
- Tweenies** - ages 3 - 5
- Preschool** - ages 4 - 5
- Afterschool** - ages 5 - 12
- Babysitting Service** -if space permitting

All spaces are reserved in the Centre and fees correspond to the amount of time booked; paid one month in advance. There are subsidized spaces available with funding provided to eligible families by the Dept. of Community Services.

- Open daily** Monday to Friday from 6:45am to 5:30pm
- Dedicated Staff** Fully qualified with ECE, First Aid and CPR
- Healthy** Lunch and snacks prepared by a full time nutritional planner
